## Competition Guide & Rules

- ✓ **Rounds 7 & 8: Verona (ITA), 3-4 June**
- ✓ **Rounds 9 & 10 Sandness (NOR), 17-18 June**

### 1. 2017 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP TEAM RANKING

The 2017 UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will consist on 10 rounds. All races count.

All teams have to register through UEC prior to the first event of the season in order to take part in the 2017 UEC BMX European Cup Teams Competition.

The overall award ceremony will be held in Sandness (NOR), on the Sunday, June 18th with Team coaches and maximum 4 riders.

The UEC BMX Commission will award 3 trophies to the 3 first teams and one medal to each rider of the team:

- Gold medal for the 1<sup>st</sup> team's riders of the 2017 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking
- Silver medal for the 2<sup>nd</sup> team's riders of the 2017 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking
- Bronze medal for the 3<sup>rd</sup> team's riders of the 2017 UEC BMX European Cup Team ranking
- 2017 UEC BMX European Cup – Teams

**Rules :**

- Teams wanting to participate in the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition must register maximum 10 riders and pay a registration fee to the UEC at the beginning of the season (deadline 15 March 2017) – UEC fee €200.
- UEC teams have to confirm their 4 rider participation before each event (2017 UEC BMX European Cup) together with riders' registration on Friday from 11.00 to 14.00. Teams have to fill-in the team Entry form before each race and hand in the form at rider's registration (entry form can be downloaded from the website [www.uec.ch](http://www.uec.ch)).
- riders from all classes are welcome to enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition: challenge (20 & 24') and championship.
- 10 riders maximum in a team, but points will be given only to 4 riders registered by the Team Coach.
- points will be given according to European official grid
- UEC Teams only receive team passes for an event when they enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event.
- UEC Teams that do not enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition at a UEC BMX European Cup event are treated as any other team without UEC registration.

The Organizer has to provide to UEC teams registered for a UEC BMX European Cup event:

- Spaces for team tents, as close as possible to the track, of 6 x 3 m for each team registered for that specific race, at the cost of a maximum of € 150;
- A team has to register for the team space with an organiser of a UEC BMX European Cup event, a team space will not automatically be assigned;
- Team passes as indicated below;
- Promote the name of the Team during races as listed on the moto sheets.

**UEC Team Passes:**

Each UEC Team receives the following passes at an event from the organiser when they enter the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition:

1x pass type A - with the following rights:

- Free entry to track
- Entry to staging
- Entry to track (in case of crashed rider)
- Entry to Team manager meeting
- Entry to Team manager area

1x pass type C - with the following rights:

- Free entry to track

These team passes will be provided to team managers of UEC Teams when they hand in their team registration form for the UEC BMX European Cup Team Competition.

### Other teams

The Organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of a minimum of €200.

These teams receive the following passes at an event from the organiser:

2x pass type C - with the following rights:

- Free entry to track

### Team area

UEC asks organisers to think of the placement of the team area. Make it easy for riders to go to staging from the team area and after the race from the finish line back to the team area.

Please keep the following order into account when making a team area plan:

1<sup>st</sup> priority and closest to staging: UEC registered teams

2<sup>nd</sup> priority and less close to staging: National teams

3<sup>rd</sup> priority and farthest from staging: all other teams that rented a team space
